Uniform Policy

We encourage our students to take pride in their Most Holy Trinity Catholic School uniform. Our dress code fosters the goals of Catholic education by promoting concepts of equality and community in young people. Therefore, proper school attire and grooming are considered an important element in creating an atmosphere in which educational objectives are met. Parents will be notified when students fail to comply with the school uniform policy and consequences may include, but are not limited to, loss of "dress differently" privileges. Our uniform can be purchased at National Dry Goods and various other national/local retailers.

The school administration has the final decision as to what is or is not a violation of the dress code.

Traditional Uniform

Grades PreK - 4

Girls

- 1. Skirts/Pants Navy blue pants, knee length jumper or knee length skirt, no leggings or jeggings.
- 2. Blouses/shirts light blue long or short sleeve polo.
- 3. All undershirts must be white without print.
- 4. Sweaters must be solid navy. No sweatshirts/hoodies of any kind.
- 5. Shoes must be dark in color, closed toe, and safe for gym/playground (No high heels, sandals, crocs, boots, etc...).
- 6. Hair must be kept neat, trim, and off the face.

Boys

- 1. Pants -Non-cargo type navy pants.
- 2. Shirts light blue polo shirts, long or short sleeves. All undershirts must be white without print.
- 3. Shoes must be dark in color, closed toe, and safe for gym/playground (No boots, sandals, crocs, etc...).
- 4. Sweaters must be solid navy. No sweatshirts/hoodies of any kind.
- 5. Hair must be kept neat, trim, and off the face.

<u>Grades 5 – 8</u>

Ladies

- 1. Skirts/Pants: navy blue skirts must be no more than one inch above the knee. Waist of skirt may not be rolled. Navy blue uniform pants, non-cargo, loose fitting.
- 2. Shirts: light blue, button-down Oxford style, long or short sleeve; sleeves may not be rolled to the elbow. All undershirts must be white without print. **All shirts are to be tucked in and only top button may be left unbuttoned.**
- 3. Shoes must be dark in color, closed toe and safe for gym/playground (No high heels, sandals, crocs, boots, etc...).
- 4. Sweaters: Sweaters may be navy or black. Button down, pullover, V-neck or sleeveless are acceptable. No sweatshirts/hoodies of any kind.
- 5. Hair must be kept neat, trim, and off the face.
- 6. No hats, make-up, tattoos, or body piercings permitted.

Gentlemen

- 1. Pants navy blue uniform pants, non-cargo, loose fitting and must be worn with a belt.
- 2. Shirts light blue, button-down dress shirt, Oxford style, long or short sleeve; sleeves may not be rolled to the elbow. All undershirts must be white without print. All shirts are to be tucked in.
- 3. Suitable ties without pictures or words (neck ties and bow ties are acceptable).
- 4. Belt worn at the waist must be black, navy or brown.
- 5. Shoes must be dark in color, closed toe, and safe for gym/playground (No boots, sandals, crocs, etc...).
- 6. Sweaters may be navy or black. button down, pullover, V-neck or sleeveless are acceptable. No sweatshirts/hoodies of any kind.
- 7. Hair must be kept neat, trim, and off the face.
- 8. No hats, tattoos, body piercings, or make-up permitted.

Alternative or Free Dress Days

On school days designated as "dress different" or "free dress" days, students may wear casual clothing.
